#### '21 Bethany Ridge Petit Manseng

A medium-bodied wine with heady aromas of lush tropical fruit that lead into notes of apricot, passion fruit and yellow apple

# '21 Paeonia White

An opulent white wine, with aromatics of ripe pear, honeyed apricot, and lightly toasted apricots. A hint of delicate floral undertones. Dense, sappy mouthfeel full of tropical fruits, baking spice, and crème brulee leads into a wonderful acidic driven finish.

### '20 Russ Mountain Merlot

Russ Mountain produces what on might refer to as "mountain fruit" qualities in the wine – a brambly, spicey, very open and pronounced aromatic intensity followed by a dense and vibrant mid-palate.

### '21 Bethany Ridge Tannat

Highly ripe, very powerful, with potent, slightly grippy tannins. What is most exciting about the Bethany Ridge Tannat is how the wine will age over the next ten years. There is no reason to expect that is will not develop and become more and more interesting over time.

# '19 Late Harvest Petit Manseng

Rich, with restrained intensity, this has aromas of toasted graham-cracker crumb, spiced orange marmalade, peach preserves and wilted rose. It feels slightly pudgy on the midpalate, with a tapering finish that ends on a buttered-caramel note.
